Four Problems Pride Creates with Other People

1. Pride Produces
Pride only breeds quarrels Proverbs 13:10
2. Pride Provokes
Let us not become conceited provoking and envying one another Galatians 5:26
Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. Romans 12:16
Don't try to act big. Don't try to get into the good graces of important people, but enjoy the company of ordinary folks. And don't think you know it all! Romans 12:16 (The Living Bible)
Prideful bragging is counterproductive and alienates,

3. Pride Prevents
Pride protects itself. Pride is aloof and superficial.

Pride Destroys Relationships

Mary, Jesus' Mother, An Example of Humility

But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. Luke 2:19

What Humility is NOT:

- Humility is not insecurity
- Humility is not self-consciousness
- Humility is not phony modesty

My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed, for the Mighty One has done great things for me—holy is his name. Luke 1:46-49

Humility—Discovering what God has gifted you to do, and doing it to the best of your ability for His glory and not your own.

"This child is destined to cause the falling and rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be spoken against, so that the thoughts of many hearts will be revealed. And a sword will pierce your own soul too." Luke 2:34-35

How do we develop Humility?

Demonstrate Humility at Work

- Instead of demanding your rights—defer to ______
- Instead of promoting yourself—praise others
- Instead of lying to cover up—tell the truth
- Instead of seeing how little you can do—do more for others than they rightfully expect
