#### Evangelicals have not done well communicating the truth to the next \_\_\_\_\_

- 66% lie to teachers and parents
- 33% cheated in exams with last three months
- 11% had been drunk
- 10% used illegal drugs
- 20% had tried to physically hurt another person
- 40% of church kids did not believe their faith can be objectively shown to be true
- 21% do not believe it matters what faith you have
- 55% of church kids had been involved sexually

Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. **Deuteronomy 11:19** 

Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land that the LORD swore to give your forefathers, as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth.
